5th Grade Charity Fundraising Project

Initial Phase

- 1. Research various charities
- 2. Choose a charity
- 3. Write a one-page (double-spaced typed) summary of your charity, answering the following items:
- What is the Mission statement of charity (motto)?
- Purpose what does the charity do specifically to help?
- How many people does it help per year?
- How much of every dollar goes to people in need?
- Why did you choose this charity? What is your personal connection?
- What countries are helped by this charity?
- Show images of people helped by this charity

Planning Phase

- 1. Decide how much money you would like to raise for this charity
- 2. Decide how much time you will spend to raise this money
- 3. Decide how you will raise this money
- 4. Identify the number of people from whom you will need support
- 5. List all the materials you will need for your fundraiser (think about everything possible)
- 6. Will volunteers be paid or unpaid
- 7. Come up with a slogan should include items being sold or event being held in the slogan
- 8. Come up with a sales pitch (what you are going to say to potential donors)

Numbers Phase

- 1. Identify the amount you wish to raise
- 2. Identify the cost of each item on your materials list (ask parent's permission if you use the internet at home for research)
- 3. Calculate the total cost of all materials include sales tax
- 4. Determine cost vs. profit
- 5. Determine the TOTAL you need to raise to cover your costs and what you would like to raise

Results Phase

- 1. Determine whether or not you reached your goal
- 2. Determine the total amount you made
- 3. Determine how much was actually donated to your charity after paying your expenses
- 4. Determine how many people donated
- 5. Determine the average amount each person donated
- 6. Create a graphical representation of your finances

Presentation Phase

Gather all your data onto one display board (include all papers, graphs, illustrations, pictures, etc.)

Create a one page (double-spaced type) discussion detailing the successes or failures of your fundraising campaign; tell how you have improved your efforts

Create a summary (minimum of sic sentences in a paragraph) detailing how this fundraising campaign has changed (i.e. are you a better person?)
